

How to reach Faroe Islands and Iceland

By air.

The Faroe Islands. There are direct flights to [Vagar Airport](#) (FAE) from Denmark, England, Iceland and Norway. [Atlantic Airways](#) has several departures from Copenhagen every day as well as from Billund a few times a week. Bicycles can be checked-in and are included in your free baggage allowances. If your weight exceeds free baggage allowance DKK 40 will be charged per extra kg. Pedals must be removed and the steering bar put parallel with the chassis.

Iceland. [Icelandair](#) operates flights to [Keflavik International Airport](#) (KEF), located 50 km from Reykjavik, from the USA, Canada and many European countries including Lithuania and Poland (with 1 stop in Copenhagen). Bicycles are accepted as [Medium Items](#).

Budget airline [WOW Air](#) flies into Keflavik from major European towns. There are direct flights from Vilnius and Warsaw as well. Bicycles are accepted as checked luggage up to 23 kg for 30 Euro and must be wrapped in plastic, boxed or packed in a bicycle bag. You can purchase a bag at check-in in Keflavik for 1500 ISK.

From the Faroe Islands take [Atlantic Airways](#) to [Reykjavik International Airport](#) (REK) located near the centre of Reykjavik.

By sea.

There is a direct ferry link between Hirtshals in north of Jutland in Denmark and Iceland's port Seyðisfjörður located on the east coast twice a week during the summer with the ferry "Norröna". In addition Norröna sails from Iceland to the Faroe Islands once a week connecting the Faroe Islands to Iceland and mainland Europe. You can book tickets on www.smyrilline.com.

Our BaltiCCycle support van with office stuff and bicycles will go on this ferry leaving Hirtshals on July 4, Saturday, 15:30. It will arrive to Faroes port Tórshavn next day, Sunday, 22:30 and stay in Faroes 3 days. On July 8, Wednesday, 18:00 it will leave to Iceland arriving to Seyðisfjörður next day morning, Thursday, 8:30. Driving the car from Seyðisfjörður to Keflavik (~600 km) will take 2 days.

After the ride the support car will take a ferry from Seyðisfjörður to Hirtshals on August 13, Thursday, 10:30.

If you have a time you are welcome to join us on "Norröna".

Around Iceland. If you join the ride not for the whole distance you can reach us easily in different parts of the route. There are numerous daily services from [BSi bus station](#) in central Reykjavik. You can find a map of scheduled busses and book the ticket at [Forsíða](#).
